Educational framework for your child

- Teaching and educational support at a distance.

- Weekly follow-up with you, your child and the school.
- Technical support for the use of equipment specially designed for teaching and learning at a distance.

- Free access to digital versions of textbooks, notebooks and other resources from the main schoolbook publishers, even to school year end.
- Access to the school, following a predetermined process, to recover the notebooks, textbooks, and technical equipment.
- The *Alloprof* services continue to be accessible for all Québec students and parents.

Your child's role:

- To be aware of the work plan furnished by his or her teacher and to follow it.
- To adopt and follow a regular schoolwork schedule.
 **Trick:** Use the educational menus available on [École ouverte](#) to plan a typical week.
- To participate in courses offered at a distance by the teachers, if applicable.
- To complete the planned work within a fixed timeframe.
 **Trick:** Tap into the available resources.

Your role as a parent

- To make available both the appropriate technical equipment and the space for your child to study.
- To understand the work plan and to help your child to set up the schoolwork schedule.
- To accompany and support your child in his or her educational development.
